A church at the heart of a neighbourhood, in the hearts of the people



Despite the passage of time and numerous historic and social upheavals, the church of Saint-Pierre-Apôtre has remained a gathering place. It is an open space, where unconditional hospitality reigns, and whose reputation transcends the physical boundaries of the parish.

Over the course of your visit, we invite you to discover the first architectural work, and one of the greatest masterpieces, of Victor Bourgeau. You will cross paths with people who marked the history of both the parish and the city, including Mgr. Ignace Bourget, Mgr. Eugène de Mazenod, Pierre Beaudry, Sir George-Étienne Cartier, and the Sulpicians.

This flyer shows the recommended routes and points of interest. The numbers on the maps indicate the starting point for each of the 20 downloadable audio stops of the virtual tour. Throughout the visit, the narrator will guide you and point out the audio stops to select.


To begin your tour, please position yourself facing the 1201 de la Visitation Street, and select Stop No. 1.
